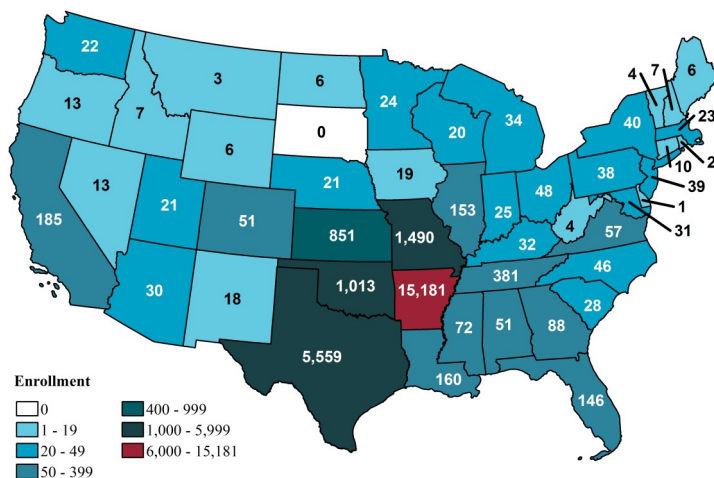

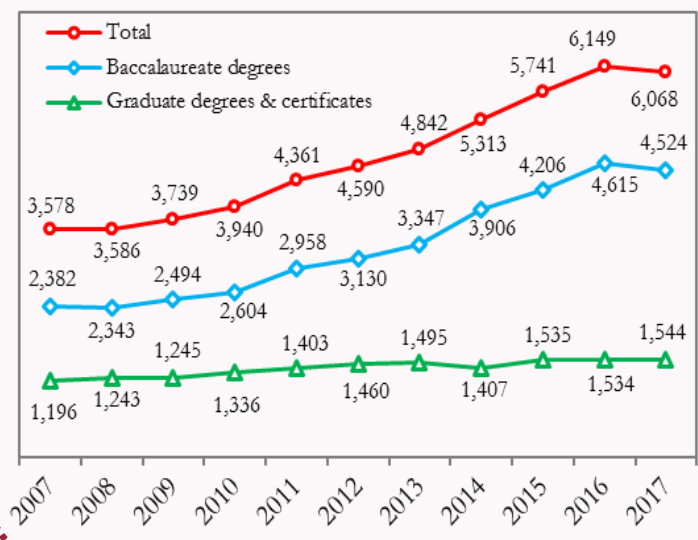

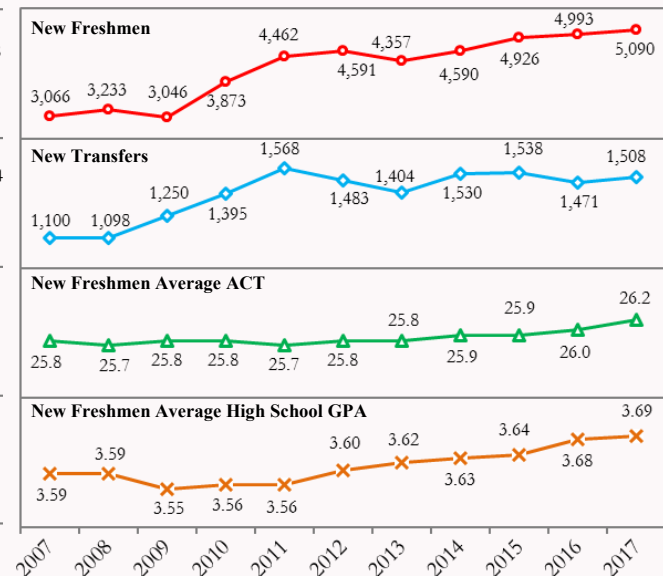
ENROLLMENT TRENDS



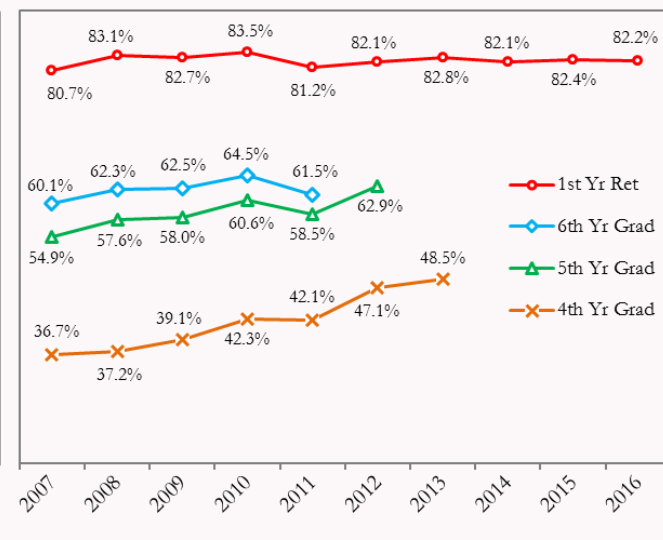
CREDENTIALS AWARDED TRENDS
