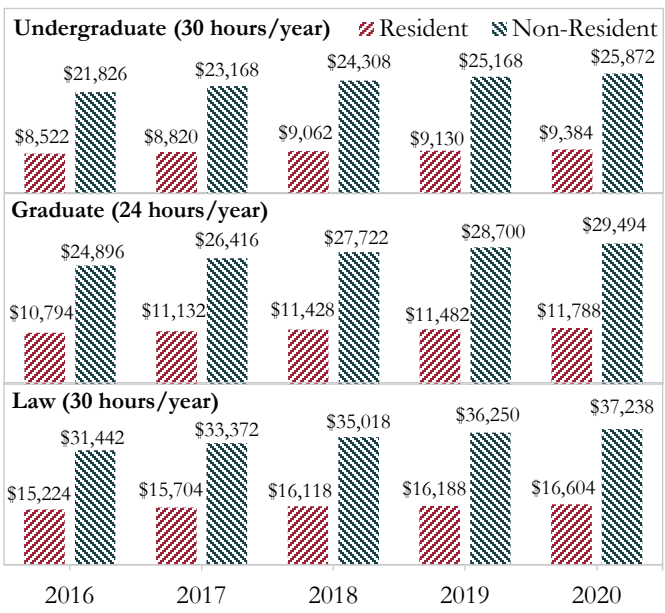

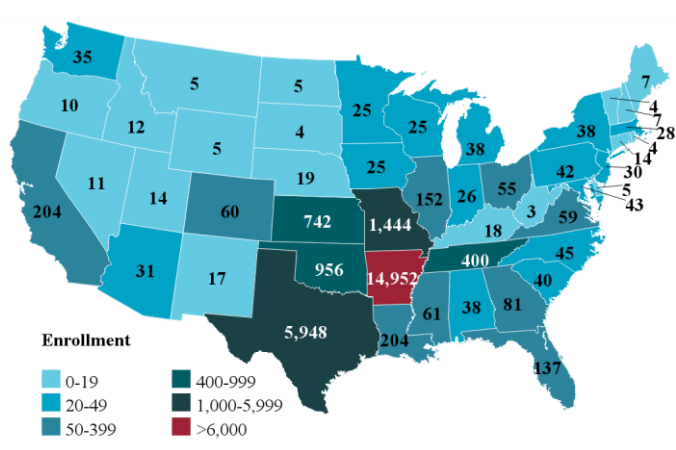

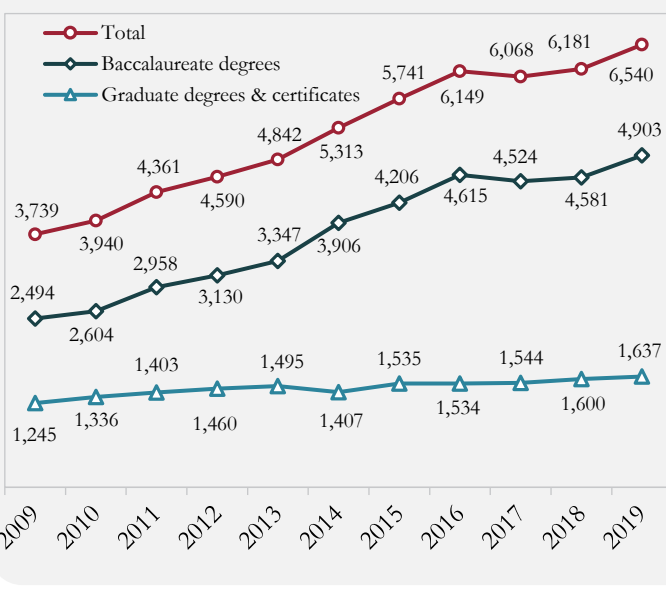

Enrollment Trends



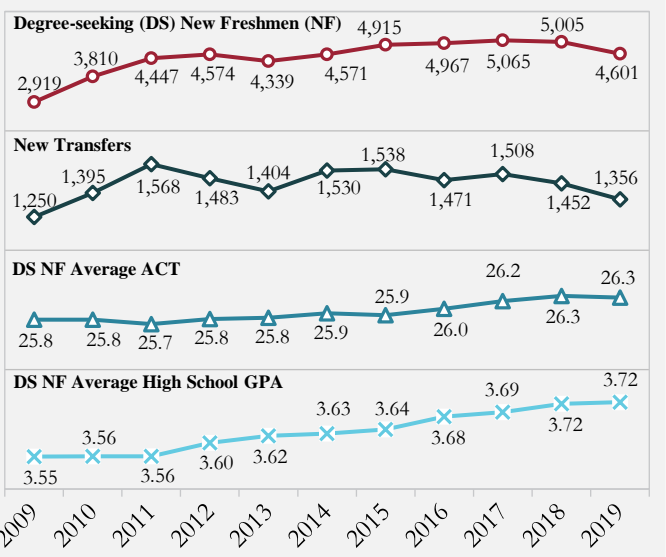

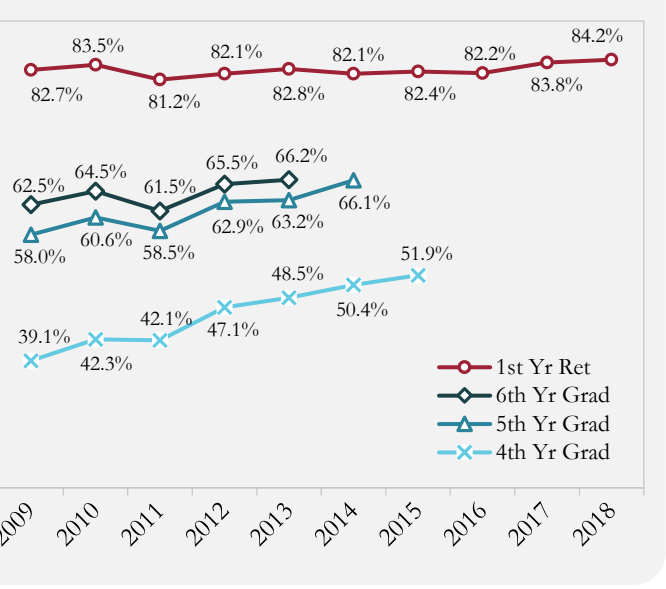
